

Cap Fréhel – Reloaded – Letterbox

(placed Juli 2017 by WormserWanderWölfe)

Location: Bretagne, Cote d'Armor, Plevenon

Start: Parking spot at Cap Fréhel (3,- € fee)

Equipment: compass, stamp, stamp pad and logbook

Difficulty: easy

Terrain: easy-middle, gravel roads and paths, partially loose stones / rocks;

Please do not go in case of rain or smoothness - danger of falling

Length: approx. 1.0 km

Infos:

This letterbox is thought of rather as a short walk on vacation, but can be extended. The sister box Fort la Latte is connected to this by the GR 34. The distance is accessible from here by a 1.5-hour hike (tip: there is the parking free).

Beware of Muggles, the cap is strongly visited (in the evening is much less loose and parking is free)

Clue:

Look at the big lighthouse more closely; How many windows do you find on the square part of the lighthouse over the ground floor on all sides?

This is value A = _____

Next to the big one there is also an older lighthouse. How many small windows you see on the east side of the tower; B = _____

Now take the path to the smallest of the towers.

The number of window openings also counts here; C = _____

From the tower you find in about 200 ° a boundary stone with an anchor on it.

Go there and target it in $B \times 100 + A + C + C = \text{_____}^\circ$

In $B \times B \times 5 = \text{_____}$ steps, you stand on a stone plate.

$B + C + C = \text{_____}$ steps further you are at the edge of the rock and can see the sea rushing under you.

In $C \times A \times 10 + A = \text{_____}^\circ$ and approx. $B + C = \text{_____}$ m, the letterbox is hidden under a rock nose behind stones.

Be very careful and pay attention to other tourists.

As a tip: from the hiding place you can see all 3 lighthouses ☺
